Cooperators was officially set up as a "Pious Union" by St. John Bosco himself, the third branch of the Salesian Family. From the very beginning, they are together with and share the same charism as the Salesians of Don Bosco (SDB) and Daughters of Mary Help of Christians (FMA), who are dedicated in the Church to an extensive apostolate among the young and the poor.

Celebrant: What do you know about the Project of Apostolic Life for the Salesian Cooperators?

Aspirants: Yes, we know that Salesian Cooperators are the true Catholics who aspire to live out the faith in Baptism
